Anthropology Minor- Biological Track

The minor in anthropology with an emphasis on the biological subfield provides a thorough introduction to the study of humans as biological organisms. Students explore the evolution and variation of humans and their relatives from the earliest ancestors to the present. The minor requires 15 credit hours in anthropology. Students must complete ANT 2200, ANT 3300 and 3301 and two additional courses from the list below. Anthropology minor program guidelines

Credit hours required A minimum of 15 credit hrs. 1000 level courses shall not be counted in the minor. At least 6 credit hrs must be at the 3000-level or above.

Transfer and EM credit hours allowed A student is permitted to count up to 6 total hours of transfer credit and/or credit by examination.

Overlap with the GE A student is permitted to overlap up to 6 credit hours between the GE and the minor.

Overlap with the major and additional minor(s)

- The minor must be in a different subject than the major.
- The minor must contain a minimum of 12 hours distinct from the major and/or additional minor(s).

Grades required

- Minimum C- for a course to be listed on the minor.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA on all minor course work.
- Course work graded Pass/Non-Pass cannot count on the minor.
- No more than 3 credit hours of course graded Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory may count toward the minor

X193 credits No more than 3 credit hours.

Minor approval The Anthropology Minor – Biological Track – must be approved by the undergraduate advisor in the Department of Anthropology, Cameron Beason.

Filing the minor program form The minor program form must be filed at least by the time the graduation application is submitted to a college/school advisor.

Changing the minor Once the minor program is filed in the college office, any changes must be approved by the academic unit offering the minor.
